### Request for comments on the draft of the National Frequency Allocation Table (NFAT)

In line with the responsibilities of Rwanda Utilities Regulatory Agency (RURA) provided in the law No.44/2001 of 30 November 2001 governing telecommunication in Rwanda, especially as provided by Article 32 stipulating that all usage of radio frequencies in the country must be exclusively based on the National Frequency Allocation Table (NFAT); RURA is in the process of developing the table.

The table (NFAT) is aligned with the international frequency allocations agreed in the World Radio Conferences as contained in the Radio Regulations of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU).

To ensure that the National Frequency Allocation Table is developed in consultation with relevant stakeholders, RURA is requesting your comments and views on the first draft of the NFAT downloadable at <http://www.rura.gov.rw/docs/nfat.pdf>. All comments and inputs relating to the draft of the NFAT are kindly requested to be sent before 30 June 2010 to this address: [nfat@rura.gov.rw](mailto:nfat@rura.gov.rw).

Comments and observations from all stakeholders will be compiled and taken in consideration in the development of the final NFAT. The final table will contain all the frequency allocations that can be used within the Republic of Rwanda and shall be described by frequency bands and services allowed in each band.
